Prayer Needs

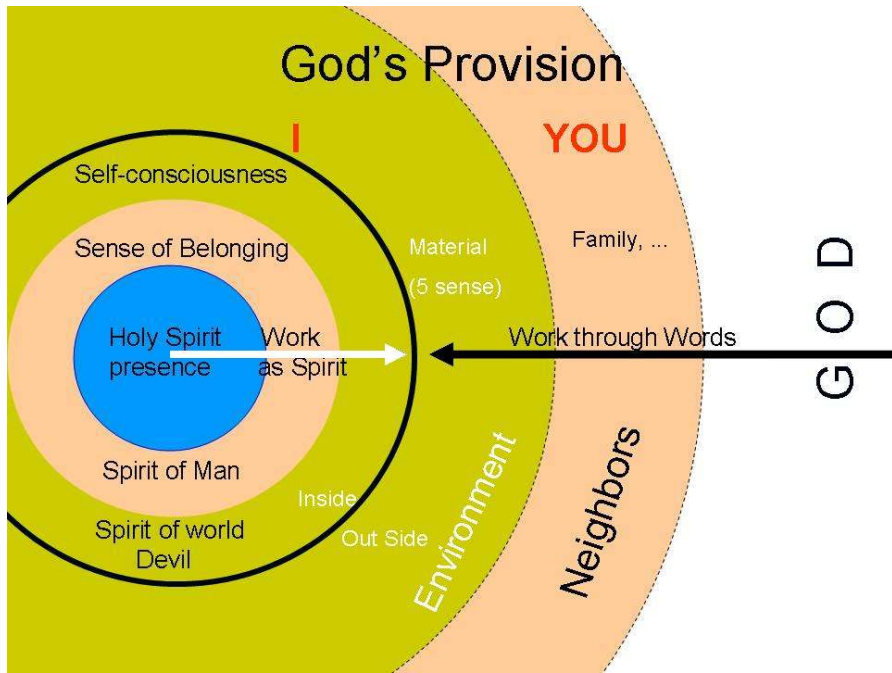
- 1) ANCOG being His channel for the need of people in Hillsborough

Scripture of the Week

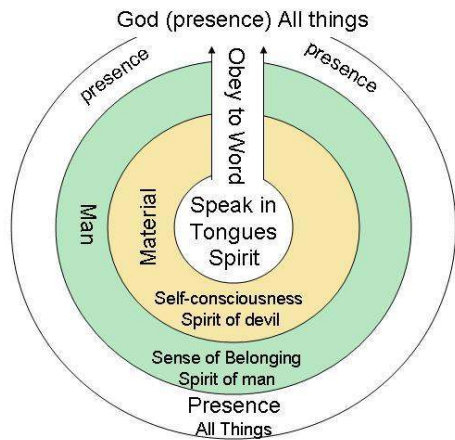
1 Corinthians 13:4-8 Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant (5) or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; (6) it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. (7) Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. (8) Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away.

2 Timothy 1:3-5 I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. (4) As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy. Necessity of Speaking in Tongues



You are now in a spiritual siege by the devil (self-consciousness) and men (sense of belonging). Praying only for problems of material and family means that you are totally surrounded (faith of prosperity, pagan religion). God therefore allowed believers to pray in Spirit (Mar 16:17). The only way out is obeying the word and praying in Spirit.

(1 Corinthians 14:2) For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth *him*; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
