- 3) Cell Group Ministry: Spirit filled and multiplying Home Churches to fulfill above.

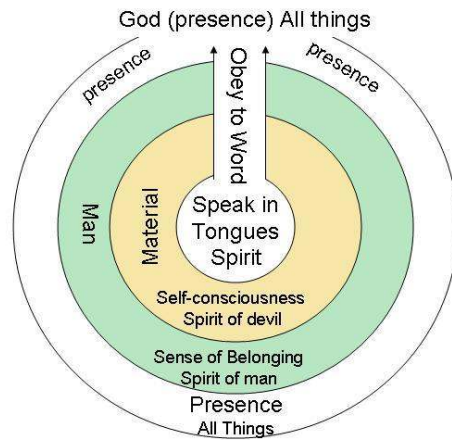
Scripture of the Week

John 15:1-5 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. (2) Every branch of mine that does not bear fruit he takes away, and every branch that does bear fruit he prunes, that it may bear more fruit. (3) Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you. (4) Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. (5) I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

"Mysteries of the Head III"

(Example as a living Sacrifice - a prospect member)
Hebrews 13:15-17 Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name. (16) Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God. (17) Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you.

Necessity of Speaking in Tongues



You are now in a spiritual siege by the devil (self-consciousness) and men (sense of belonging). Praying only for problems of material and family means that you are totally surrounded (faith of prosperity, pagan religion). God therefore allowed believers to pray in Spirit (Mar 16:17). The only way out is obeying the word and praying in Spirit.

(1 Corinthians 14:2) For he that speaketh in an *unknown* tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth *him*; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
